Lakeland Nonprofit Collaborative Funding Grant

Open Discussion Regarding New Needs/Resources for Clients

Updates:

- **Housing:** A housing coalition meeting is scheduled for later this month, with a few additional agencies added to the conversation to get more collaboration in the community for the After Hours Program
- Lakeshore CAP: Over 400 applications have been received for WRAP and case managers are currently working on processing those applications. They still have funding to assist those in immediate risk of losing housing.
- Housing for Sex Offenders: Lakeshore CAP does not do a background check on anyone looking for housing and have worked with sex offenders and have successfully housed them, but there are a limited number of landlord who will house them. May have more luck finding housing in a more rural area. Salvation Army can take felons, as long as they do not have an active warrant but cannot take sex offenders because they house children.
- Youth Agency Network (YAN): Group is looking to keep youth engaged in pro-social events and serves mostly
 middle and high school students. Currently working on a scavenger hunt for youth in the community. YAN has a
