Open Discussion Regarding Needs for Agencies & Staffing

Checkbacks:

- **Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion:** Small planning group has met and will fall under the larger county-wide DEIB group and serve as the social sector arm of the larger group. The intent is to involve the Nonprofit Network in DEI once the planning group has established some of the groundwork. More information will be said for feedback on August 11th Nonprofit call.
- Great Marriages: Is offering events online and free in August as well: www.great-marriages.org/events
- Farmers Market hours/days of operation: Sheboygan 9:00AM-1:00PM at Fountain Park 8th Street, and Erie Ave, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Plymouth: 12:00PM-5:30PM, Thursdays at Fairfield Plaza, 2133 Eastern Avenue.
- Meals on Wheels: Contactless delivery available. Now offering 1 hot meal and 1 frozen meal to customers. Next week, there will be 1 cold meal offered additionally. They are looking to hire a part-time position to help with gardening (15 hours/week) this fall. They have set up two pigs as a mailbox for donations.
- American Red Cross: Their smoke alarm install program is suspended, but they are supporting the Sheboygan Fire Department. The Fire Department will install a fire alarm system in a home, rental, or apartment. They also have fire alarm systems to accommodate def or blind customers. For this, they have a bed shaker alarm.
- Nourish: Nourish held off on 7/23 'Grilling in the Garden' distanced outdoors event but stay tuned for marketing for Thursday 8/20 outdoors. Their 7th Annual 'Good Food' party fundraiser is in limbo due to COVID-19 and they may have a new format. Tentatively this event is removed from October 16th, 2020. Nourish will keep organizations and community posted on when event will be and the format of it.
- **Above & Beyond:** They have decided to cancel the 'Tastefully Childish' fundraiser this year but plan to bring it back next year. They are currently looking at alternative fundraising options.
- Bloomerang: Great Marriages shared this webinar after our meeting. This is a webinar on hosting virtual events.
