

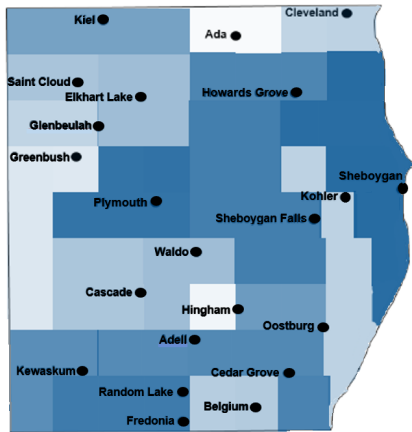


United Way of Sheboygan County

IN 2019, THE COMMUNITY ACTION FUND PROVIDED SUPPORT FOR 2 FOCUS AREA INITIATIVES & 40 PROGRAMS, WHICH PROVIDE CRITICAL SUPPORT FOR OUR COMMUNITY.



49% Supports Education

3,654 children were taught leadership and life skills through the Boy and Girl Scouts programs.

36% Supports Health

137 children were provided a single and complete forensic interview and did not have to endure multiple interviews following a traumatic event.

15% Supports Financial Stability

779 households were provided rental assistance so the families could overcome barriers and gain secure housing.
